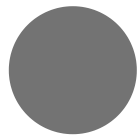
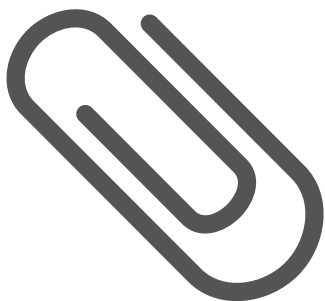
USE SLICE TO CUT

You can only have two things selected for SLICE to work



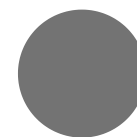
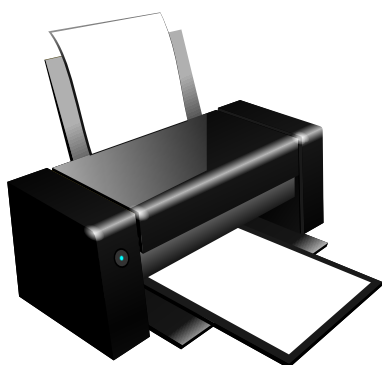
USE WELD TO JOIN TWO OR MORE THINGS THAT ARE TOUCHING

Great for connecting script fonts but remember you cannot un-weld



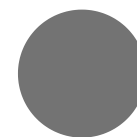
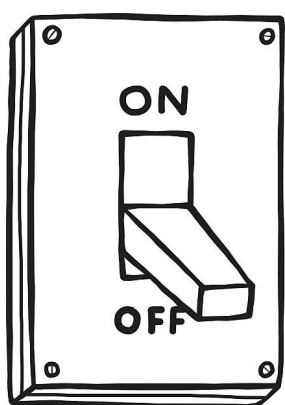
USE ATTACH TO HOLD POSITION & PLACEMENT

Attach by color to hold everything in place on your cutting mat



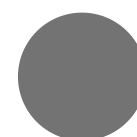
USE FLATTEN TO CHANGE A CUT IMAGE INTO A PRINT THEN CUT IMAGE

Remember to flatten to a solid shape and leave the bleed on



USE CONTOUR TO TURN ON AND OFF PARTS OF AN IMAGE

Use Duplicate and Contour to create colored layers



USE GROUP TO MAKE YOUR LAYERS WORK TOGETHER

Group does not change the way things will cut
